Business Challenge

Builders like Granite Ridge and Benedettini produce mountains of paper, consisting of detailed and constantly changing project files, material orders from multiple vendors and customer credit data, in addition to the accounts payable and receivable information all businesses generate. Document management is challenging under any circumstances; however, when SMBs want to reduce business overhead or enter new lines of business, the paper habit can have serious side effects, including choking growth and squeezing profits.

For example, Benedettini Cabinetry found its laborious and error-prone manual paper document management process unable to support its growth into new markets. The custom cabinet maker had ambitious plans to move into the distribution marketplace. This strategic growth move would have been seriously hampered without a move into digital document management.

Benedettini needed to ensure its remote sales people could perform data entry and document filing for its QuickBooks accounting system from remote locations. Working in the field allowed no room for accounting errors and no time to hunt down files and folders at Benedettini headquarters.

Solution Overview

With CNG-Books, Benedettini's nine remote salespeople are now able to access project documents at a moment's notice. This ensures that everyone working on a project is up to date, while reducing the many errors that occurred when paper files were stored, retrieved and updated manually.

Benedettini leverages CNG-Books' ability to streamline QuickBooks data entry and document filing into one consistent and efficient electronic process. The cabinet maker is able to put vendor bills, customer payments and credit card receipts (whether PDF, Microsoft Office documents, scanned and faxed images) into CNG-SAFE. With the click of a button, the data is entered in QuickBooks and the document is filed. If a folder does not exist, CNG-Books automatically creates one in CNG-SAFE using the customer/vendor information obtained from QuickBooks. Entering transactions is also painless as CNG-Books synchronizes information directly from QuickBooks

to populate pull down menus. The result is that Benedettini saves time and improves accuracy.

Granite Ridge Builders has 20 users throughout the firm using CNG-Books together with QuickBooks to share documents, streamline business processes and eliminate paper and storage space.
